INAPPROPRIATE OCC SHOEBOX ITEMS

Please do not include ANY of the following items in your shoebox gift.

- **WAR RELATED TOYS OF ANY KIND:**
Toy guns, knives, military toys, any figure holding a weapon, books showing any kind of violence
- **FOOD:**
All candy, canned or perishable food, peanuts or peanut butter, powdered Kool-Aid, etc.
- **BREAKABLE ITEMS:**
Glass mirrors, snow globes, porcelain dolls, etc.
- **LIQUIDS AND CREAMS:**
Liquids or creams of ANY kind!
Toothpaste, shampoo, lotion, bubble bath, liquid soap, hand creams or Vaseline, glue **except** glue sticks, shaving crème or aerosol cans.
- **MEDICATIONS:**
NONE!!! NO vitamins, cough drops, baby formula, etc.
- **USED OR DAMAGED ITEMS:**
NONE!
- **DANGEROUS ITEMS FOR POSSESSION IN MANY COUNTRIES DUE TO CULTURE:**
COINS OR MONEY OF ANY KIND!! Playing cards, mystical type items, such as Harry Potter
- **OTHER INAPPROPRIATE ITEMS:**
Razors
Seeds of any kind.

OCC Year-long Shopping List 

Suggestion: Start an OCC bin or drawer. As you find bargains throughout the year, stash them in your OCC spot. You will be amazed how ready for OCC you will be by Collection Week in November!!

These are only suggestions for each month. Be creative and have fun!!

January: Christmas and winter clearance items (toys, gloves, hats, etc.)

February: Valentine's Day and winter clearance items.

March: GIRLS' toys/items (dolls, jacks, Bible picture/coloring books, stickers, etc.).

April: BOYS' toys/items (cars, yo-yos, baseballs, foam footballs, Bible picture/coloring books, etc.).

May: Easter clearance items, GIRLS' personal items (socks, underwear, tees, barrettes, etc.), items on March list.

June: BOYS' personal items (socks, underwear, tees, etc.), items on April list.

July: School supplies (pencils, sharpeners, pens, spiral notebooks, crayons, colored pencils, solar calculators, etc.)

August: School supplies, health items (combs, hairbrushes, unbreakable mirrors, UN-scented soap, etc.), small flashlights with extra batteries.

September: Summer clearance items (clothes, jump ropes, sunglasses, blow-up beach balls, flip flops, etc.)

October: Take an inventory of what you have collected and look for items you still need.

November: TAKE YOUR PICTURE AND WRITE A PERSONAL NOTE TO THE CHILD GOD HAS CHOSEN TO RECEIVE IT IN A SHOEBOX. ATTEND THE PACKING PARTY!!

REMINDER: NO liquids of ANY kind, NO toothpaste, NOTHING breakable, NO food of any kind. NO war related toys (jeeps, soldiers, weapons) and NO used items.
